


There are four exhibit spaces on the first floor of Martin Luther King Jr. Memorial Library. The 10<sup>th</sup> & G Exhibit space is located in the southwest corner.




The 10<sup>th</sup> & G Exhibit Space is in a corner with windows on the south and west sides. The space does not have any direct access to the outside. The measurements shown are approximate.



At the entrance to the space is an information desk and a copier station. Within the space there are two 22" by 22" pillars. The desk, copier station and pillars are not moveable. The measurements shown are approximate.




The overall total area of the 10th and G St exhibit space is about 56' wide by 24' deep. Space will be allocated within this area on a case by case basis and coordinated with other library functions. Gallery walls are installed within this area.




MLK Library Entrance (901 G St NW)

Views of the information desk and a copier station.






The north side of the exhibit space is bordered by the glass walls of 3 meeting rooms.



There are 2 walls of windows, one on the south side and one on the west side. Each windowpane is 9ft high. Each wall is made of two rows of panes. The height of the room is 18 ft.

Mobile gallery walls may be installed at the Library's discretion. Each panel is 137.79" tall and 39.37" wide.

Gallery walls may be installed in "L" "T" "U" and "V" configurations. Each layout must be carefully reviewed for safety, stability, and accessibility considerations. A sample past gallery wall configuration in the 10th and G Street NW exhibit area is shown here.
